

Reading Passport

- Is a tool to identify the books read by the child and the frequency of library visits.
- Is a technique to monitor the reading profile, interest and habit of the child.
- Is an activity booklet where the child gives a response to a reading experience or encounter.
- Each child is given a notebook that will be used as his/her reading passport.
- When the child visits the library or reads a book from the library, he/she writes the title of the book, the author and the illustrator who made it.
- The child can draw or write his/her response on the book in the reading passport.
- The teacher can use the reading passport as an interactive journal to gauge and assess the child's literacy skills.
